ADMISSION TO PUBLIC - FREE

ARTS & CRAFTS EXHIBITOR FEE – \$75 for either a space inside the Wildwood Community Center or outside in the general event area.

Inside space is **First Come, First Served. (Indicate on Registration whether you prefer inside or outside.)**

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION –

INSIDE WILDWOOD COMMUNITY CENTER: Exhibitor will have a 6' x 8' area. Exhibitors provide their own tables & display materials but 2 chairs will be available.

OUTSIDE IN MAIN EVENT AREA: The standard Exhibitor area is a 10' x 10' space. Exhibitors provide their own tent, tables, and chairs. All exhibitor signage must be displayed within the confines of their tent space, or on the tent itself.

NO TENT STAKES are allowed. 25 lb. weights required for each tent leg.

ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS – There will be no electrical services available at this event. Exhibitors provide their own source of power if needed.

EXHIBITOR TAKE DOWN – Will commence immediately after the show closes at 6:00 PM. **No exhibitor will be allowed to remove any portion of their exhibit prior to the 6:00 PM closing.**
