<u>EXHIBITOR INFORMATION</u> – The standard Exhibitor area is a 10' x 10' space. Exhibitors provide their own tent, tables, and chairs. All exhibitor signage must be displayed within the confines of their tent space, or on the tent itself. **NO TENT STAKES are allowed**. **25** *lb. weights required for each tent leg.*
